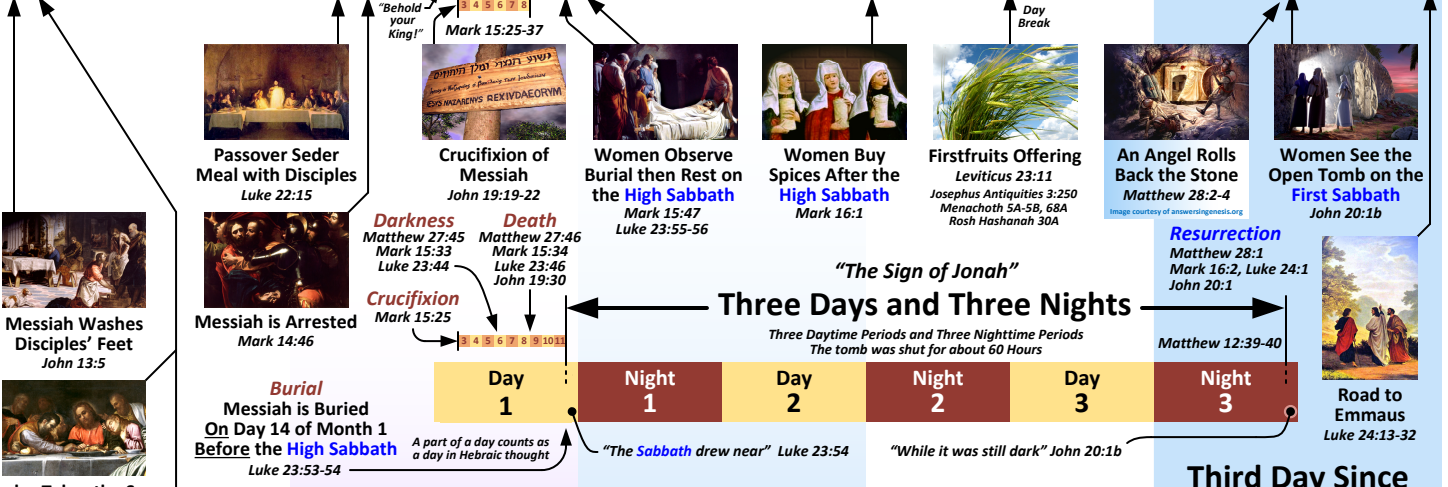

The sun and the moon testify that from the time Messiah began His Ministry in 28 C.E. (Luke 3:1-23), until after 36 C.E., when Pilate and Caiaphas were no longer in office, Passover never fell on the 5th day of the week, and only in 34 C.E. did Passover fall on the 4th day.
