When the Messiah was last on the earth, He and those following Him observed the *seventh day Sabbath*. On March 7, 321 C.E., Constantine commanded the people of the Roman Empire to rest on the venerable day of the sun. Today, many venerate the first day of the week because they believe the Messiah arose on that day – but He did not. He arose on the *seventh day Sabbath*.
